Re: Request for Regional Surface Transportation Program Fair Share Allocation

Dear Ms. Hale, 

The City of Carmel-by-the-Sea requests to allocate its 2020 Regional Surface Transportation Program (RSTIP) Fair Share allocation of \$40,310.79 to the following three (3) City projects:

- \$15,310.79 Pedestrian Safety: Sidewalk reconstruction along the west side of Mission Street, between Fifth and Sixth Avenues.
- \$15,000 Traffic Control/Safety: Paint, thermoplastic materials, and replace broken stencils for City-wide traffic striping, crosswalks, legends, and pavement markings.
- \$10,000 Clean Air/Environmental: Electrical connection for two (2) additional, dual-port EV chargers in the north parking lot of Sunset Center.

At their July 7, 2020 meeting, the Carmel City Council adopted Resolution 2020-042 authorizing the City Administrator to enter into our new Funding Agreement. A copy of that Resolution and signed Agreement are enclosed.
